The Project

The Royal Australian Navy (RAN) has procured the MV Sycamore from the Damen Shipyard Group.

The MV Sycamore will perform diverse roles for the RAN including; training, helicopter-related operations, torpedo and mine recovery, dive support, target towing, consort duties, and unmanned aerial vehicle support.

Project Highlights
