



SEA TRIALS FOR THE AIR WARFARE DESTROYER NUSHIP HOBART

The Project

The Royal Australian Navy's (RAN) Hobart Class Guided Missile Destroyers (DDG) are based on the Navantia designed F100 frigate. The vessel is coupled with the Aegis Combat System and is the first of three platforms being constructed by the Air Warfare Destroyer (AWD) Alliance at the ASC Shipyard Adelaide, South Australia, Australia.

Project Highlights – Teekay

Teekay provided civilian marine crew for the NUSHIP Hobart's sea trials program, and delivery voyage to Sydney, Australia.

Teekay also developed a standard suite of documentation for the AWD Program, to conduct sea trials command, navigation, manoeuvre and engineering functions. Teekay's experience in vessel operations and management developed a tailored and aligned set of takeover procedures and check lists to comply with regulatory and legislative requirements such as; the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA), the Work Health and Safety Act (WHS), the Navigation Act and the Defence Seaworthiness Management System.

Teekay provided a civilian marine crew of 15 persons to operate the vessel including command, navigation, manoeuvre and engineering functions during sea trials.
